

Highlights of the Plenary Meeting of the JSB Appointees on 20 June 2014 at Eurojust

Appointees from 21 Member States attended this meeting.

The President provided an interesting summary of the highlights of Eurojust's work during the past year. She also informed about the state of play of the draft Eurojust regulation and Eurojust's contributions to the data protection reform.

The Administrative Director presented the main administrative developments during 2013 at Eurojust. The Head of Operational Support informed the JSB about the developments re the Operations Manual.

The Data Protection Officer provided a presentation on the main data protection issues at stake. In relation to the data protection reform, she highlighted the effectiveness of the current supervisory system.

The Head of the Information Management Unit provided an overview of the ongoing information management projects.

The Chair of the External Relations Team provided information about the state of play of the various ongoing negotiations with third states.

Elections took place for a new permanent member. Since only one proposal of candidacy had been received from Mr Hans Frennered (Sweden), it was agreed to elect him by acclamation. Mr Carlos Campos Lobo (Portugal) will now take over as chair for the coming year and Mr Wilbert Tomesen (Netherlands) and Mr Hans Frennered will remain as permanent members.

On 23 September, the College of Eurojust has invited the JSB permanent members to the College plenary meeting for an exchange of views on the follow-up to the JSB 2013 inspection report.
