

**Opinion of the Joint Supervisory Body of Eurojust regarding the
Memorandum of Understanding on cooperation between Eurojust and the
European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights (FRA)**


On 19 June 2014, the Joint Supervisory Body of Eurojust was invited by Eurojust to give its views regarding the envisaged Memorandum of Understanding between Eurojust and the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights, in accordance with Article 26a(2) of the Eurojust Decision.

The Joint Supervisory Body appreciated very much the opportunity to provide its views regarding this proposal.

The Joint Supervisory Body welcomed the draft Memorandum of Understanding between Eurojust and the Fundamental Rights Agency and was particularly satisfied with the wording used in its Article 4(4) stating that "the exchange of information or experience provided for in this Memorandum of Understanding shall not include the transmission of operational information, including data relating to an identified or identifiable person", which is in line with the advice and recommendations given by the JSB on previous occasions.

The Joint Supervisory Body of Eurojust issues therefore a positive opinion regarding this Memorandum of Understanding.
