National Jurisprudence summary

Swedish case no. B 939-19

Court of Appeal changes the length of the sentence to 1 year but otherwise uphold the ruling of the district court. The defendant was posing during 4 occasions. The photographs and film show that all of the four persons with whom the defendant allowed himself to be photographed or filmed had been incapacitated by wounding, or were dead, or were civilians, and that two of their bodies had been mutilated, which he must also have known when he posed and had photographs taken with them. By acting as he did, the defendant consciously subjected a wounded person to humiliating or degrading treatment constituting a serious violation of that person's dignity.
